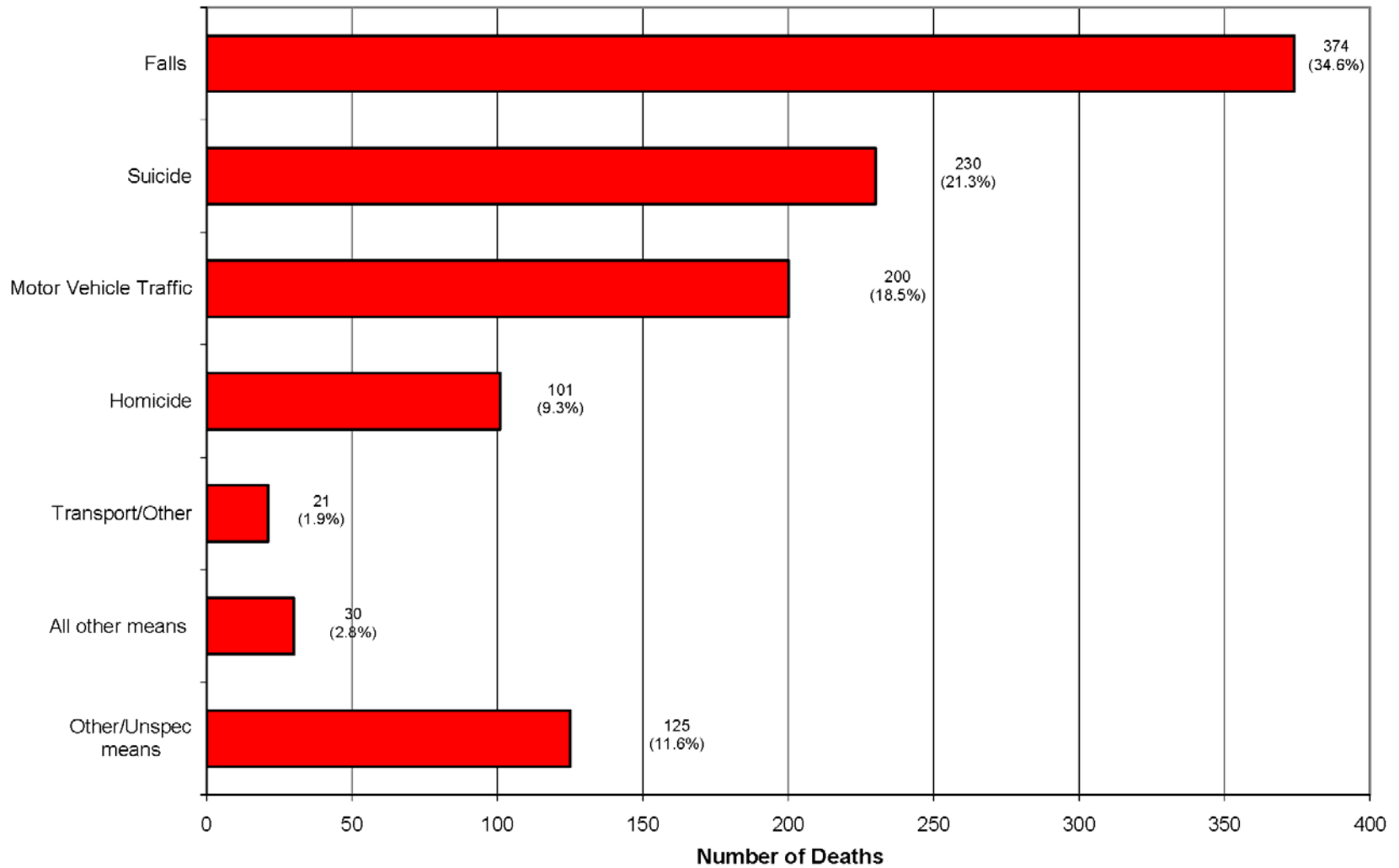


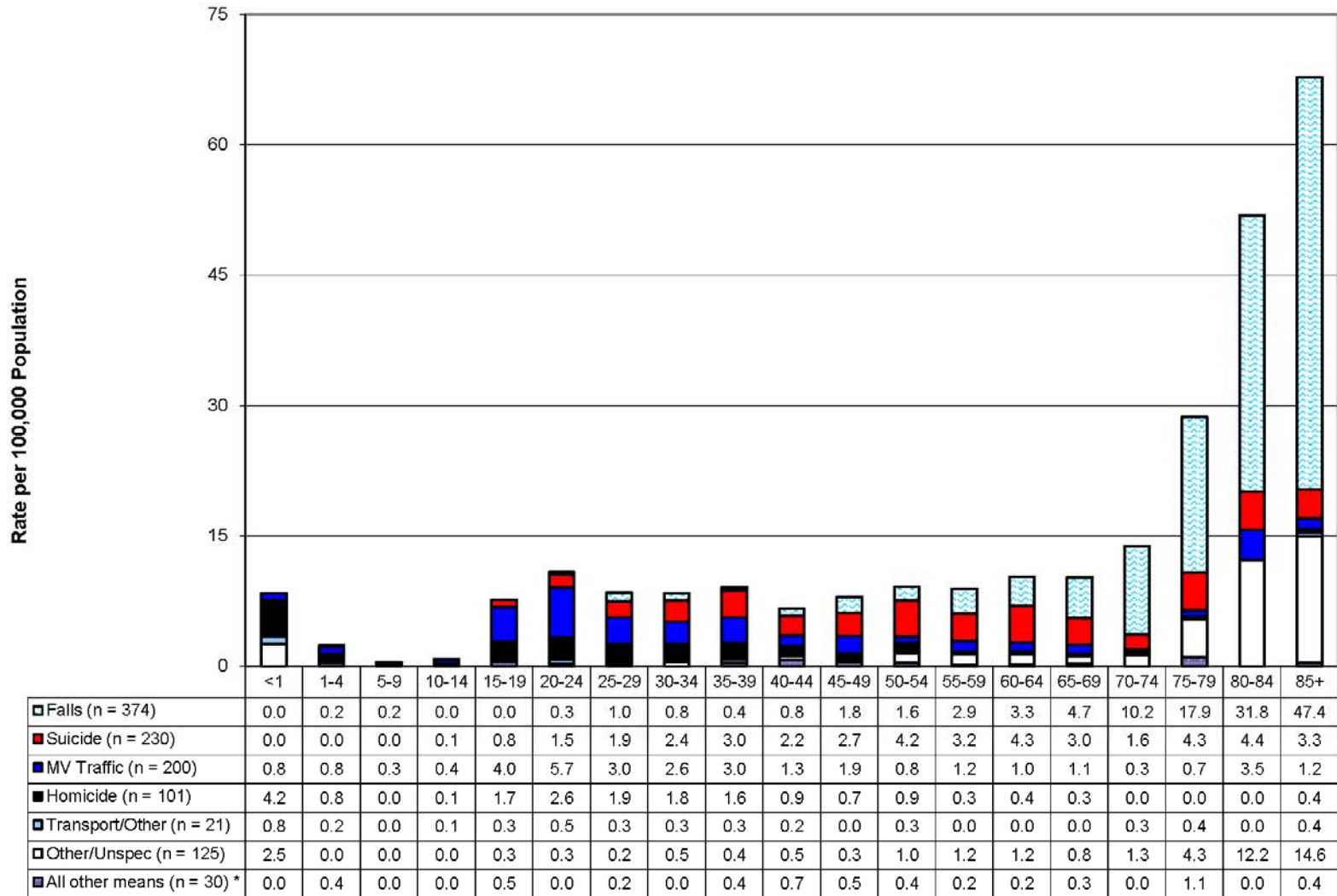

 (n = 1,081; average = 360/year)

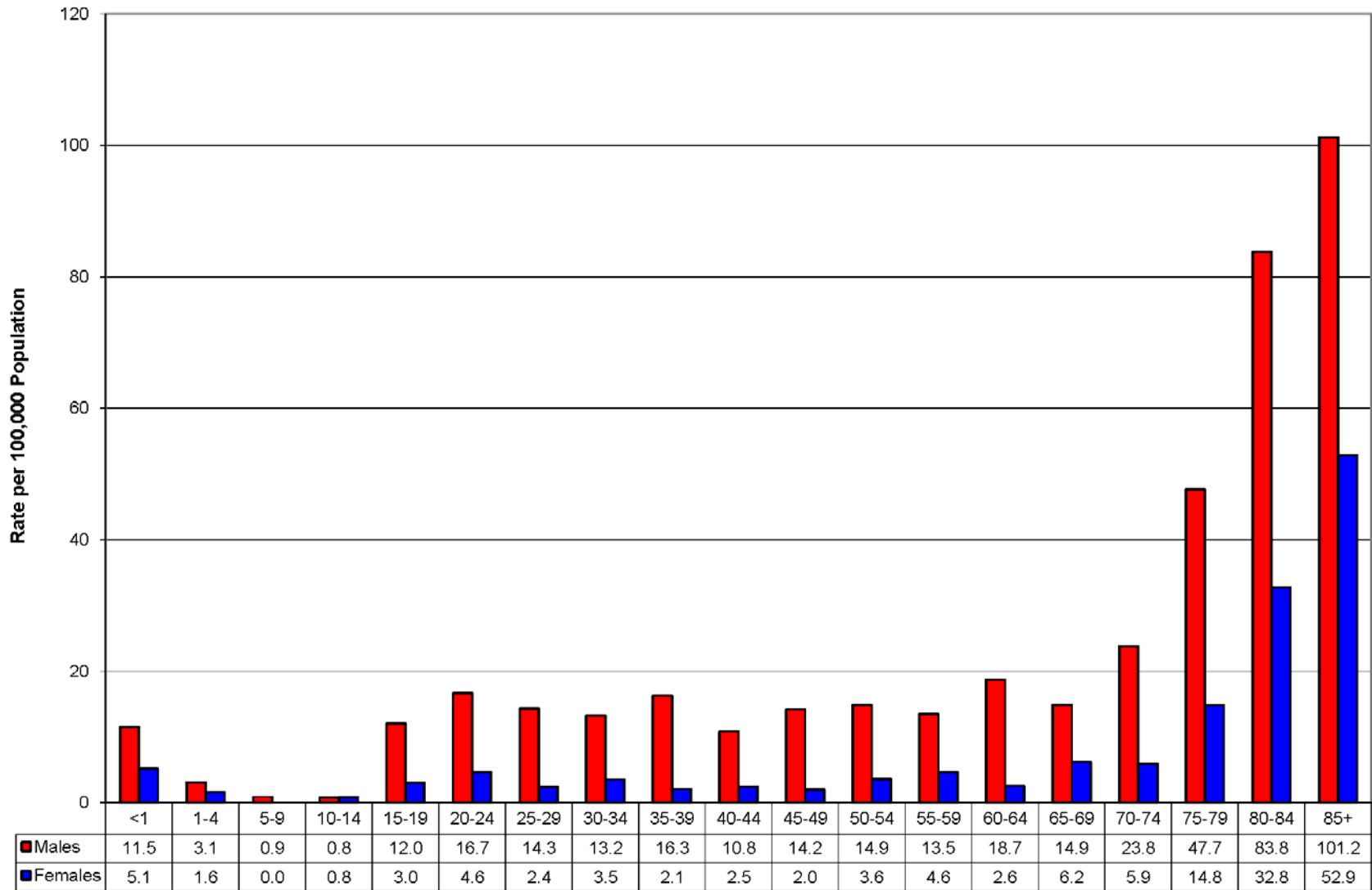


TBI Death Rates by Mechanism & Age

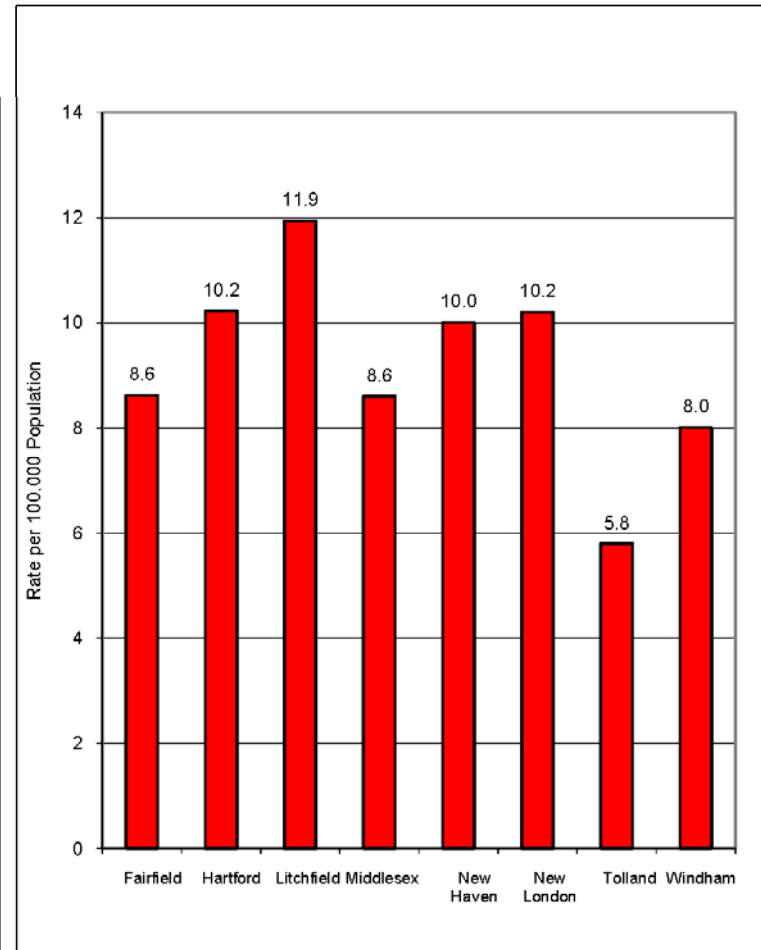

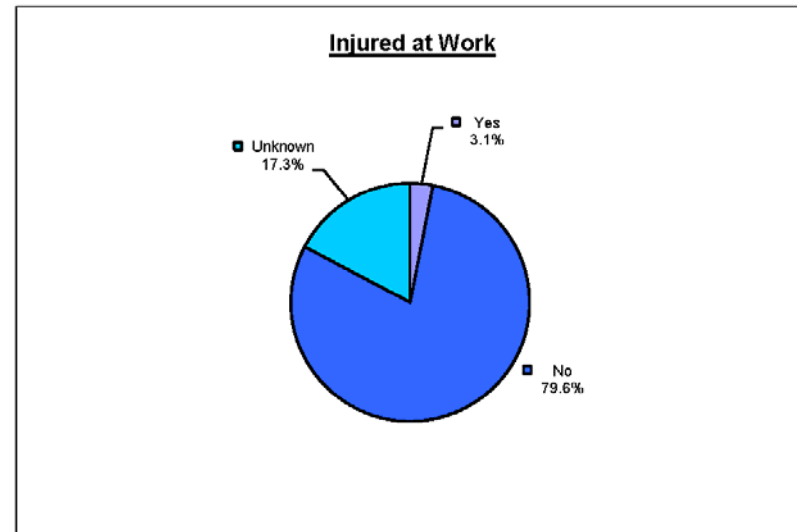
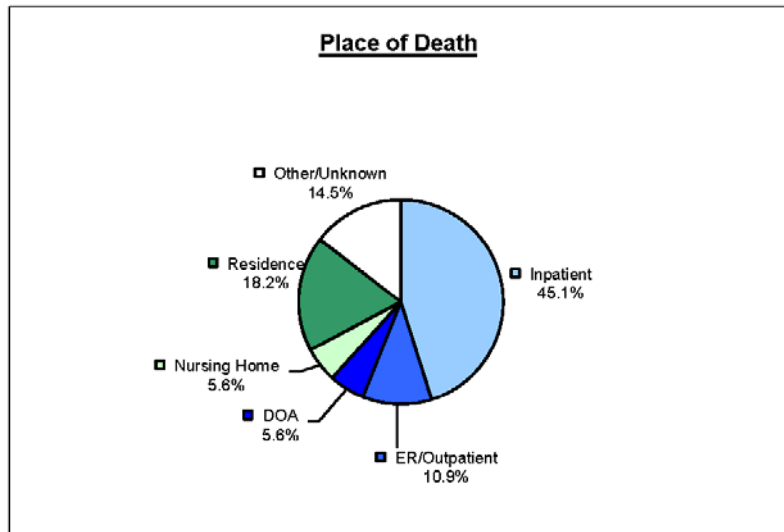
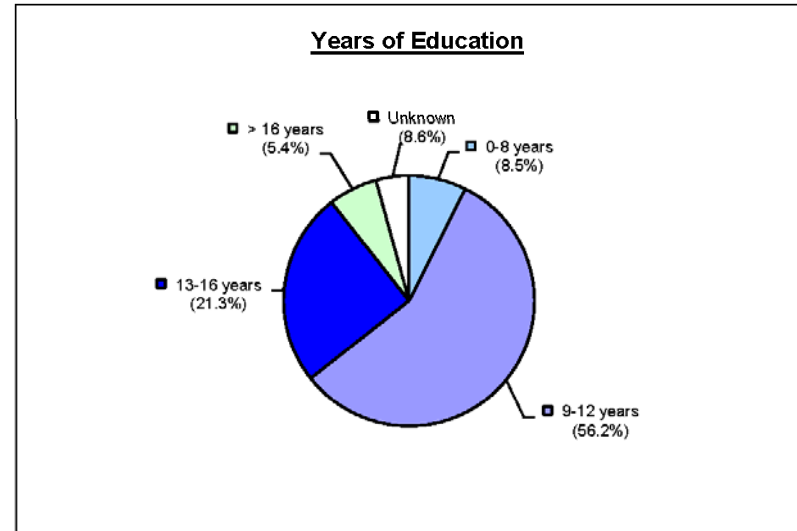
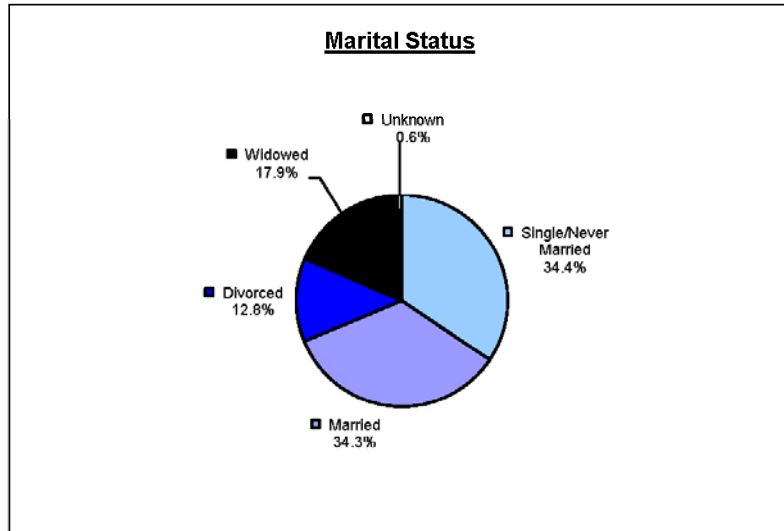
TBI Death Rates by Age & Sex
Connecticut Residents, 2005 - 2007



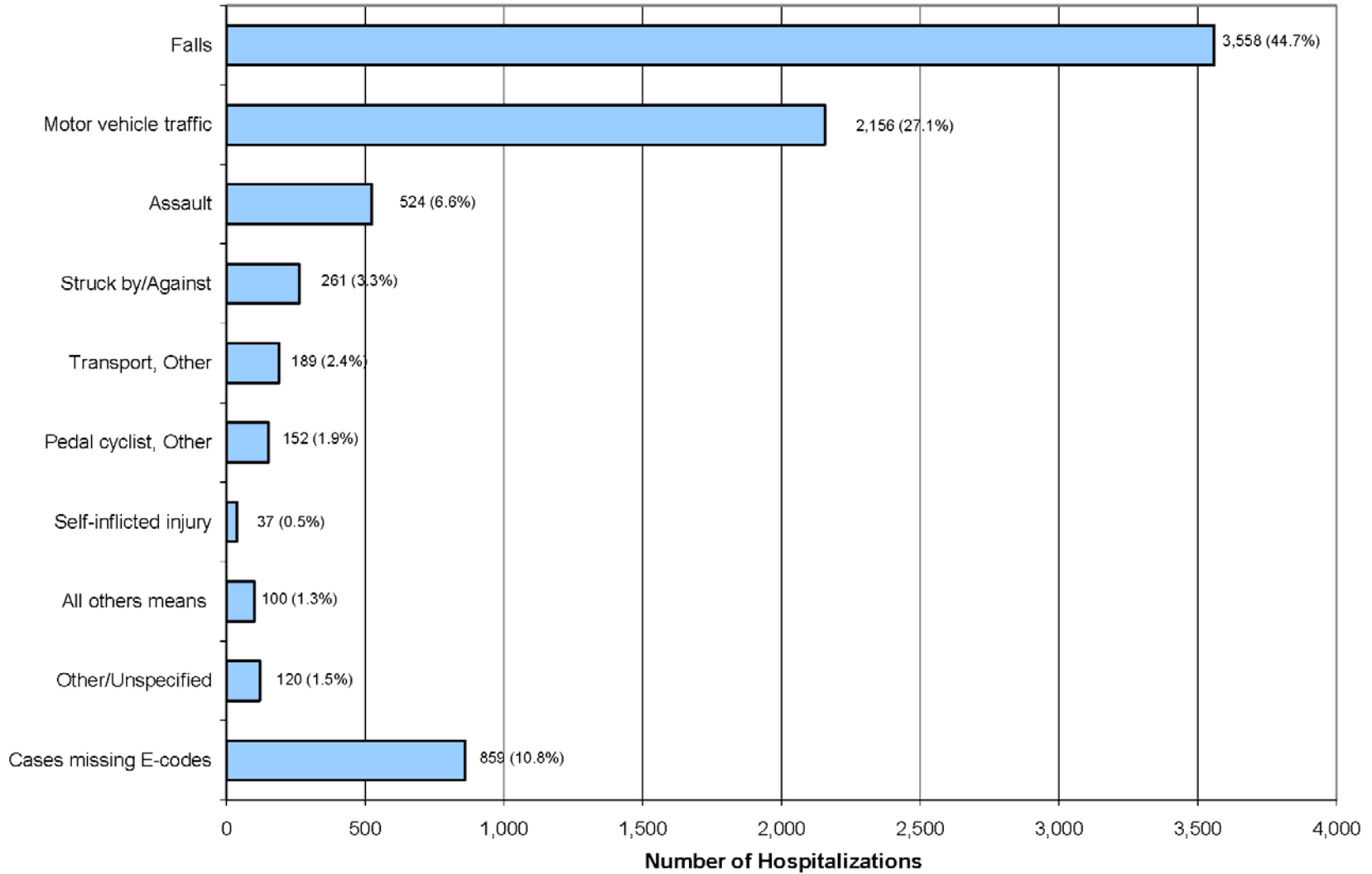
Age-Adjusted TBI Death Rates by Sex, Race/Ethnicity & County of Residence

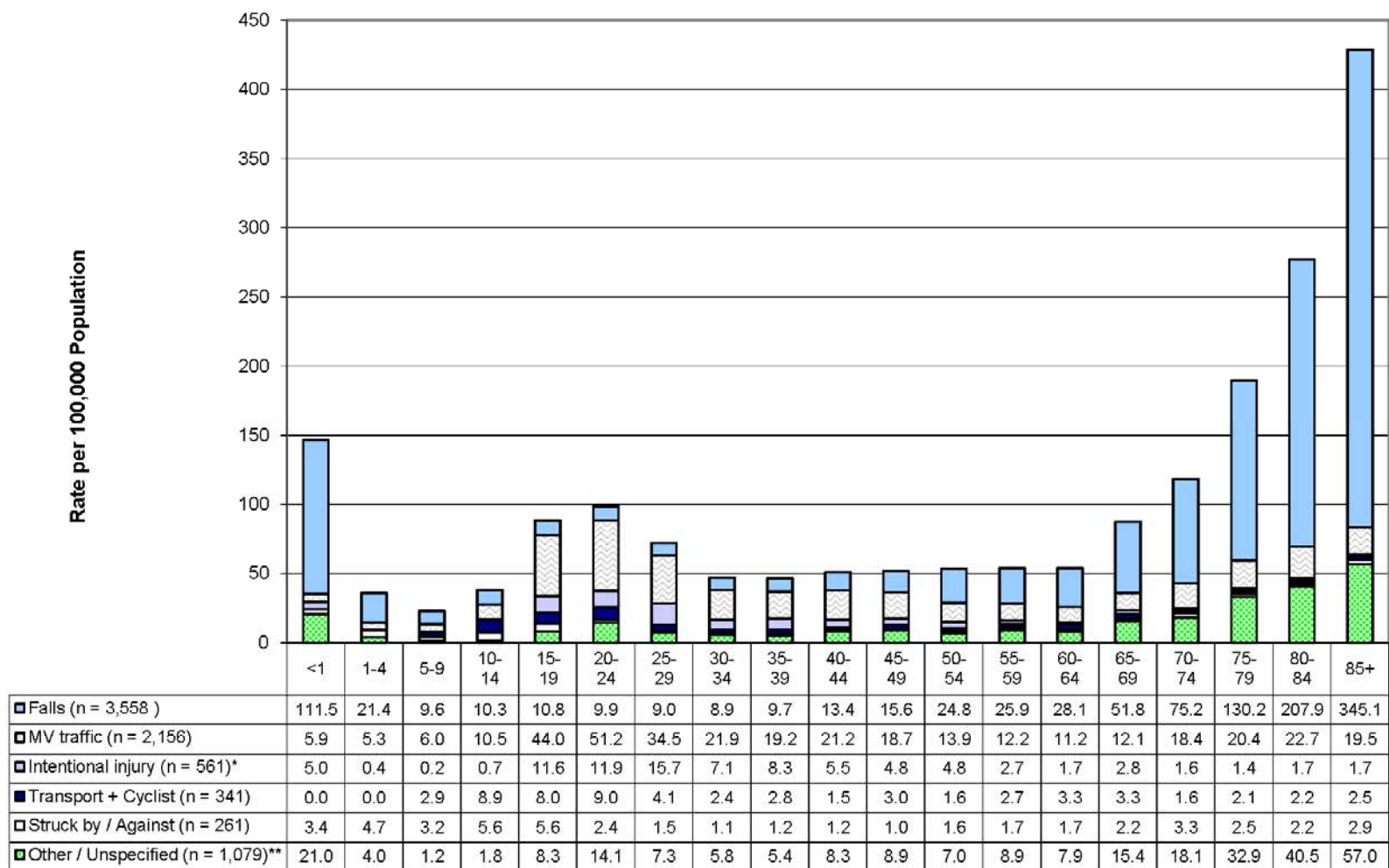
TBI Deaths by Marital & Educational Status, Other

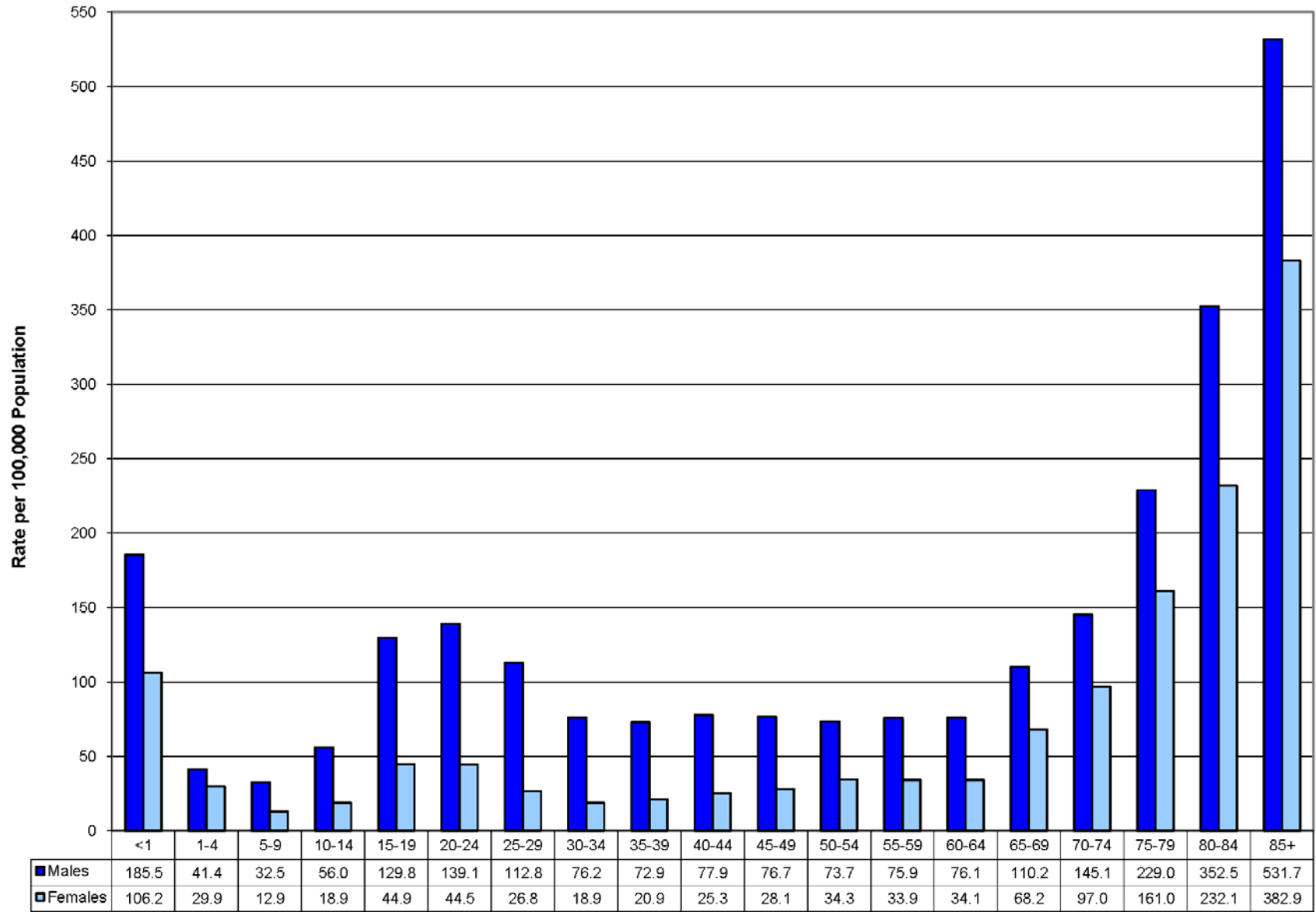
TBI Hospitalization Rates by Mechanism & Age Connecticut Residents, 2005 - 2007



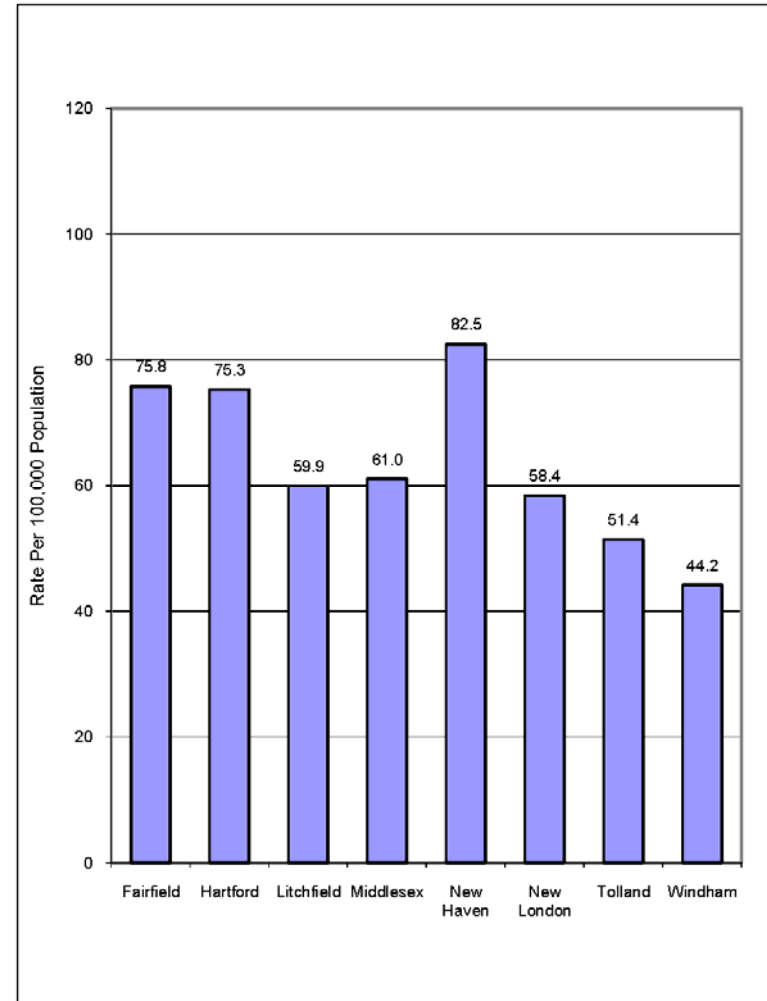
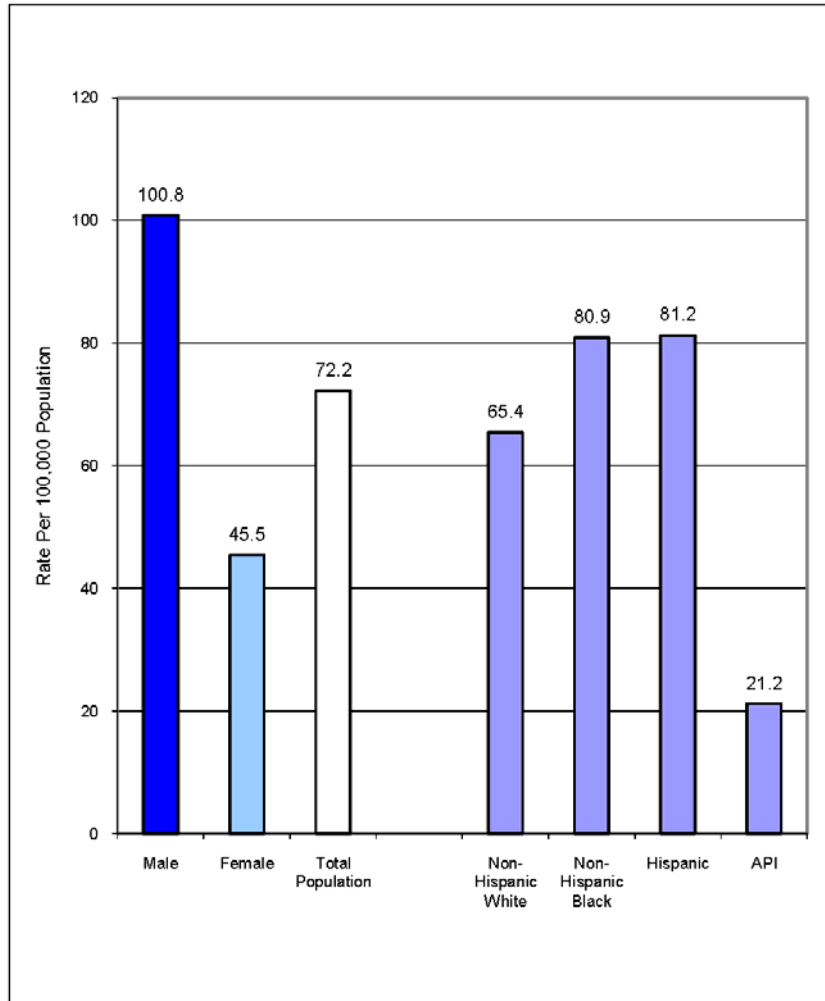

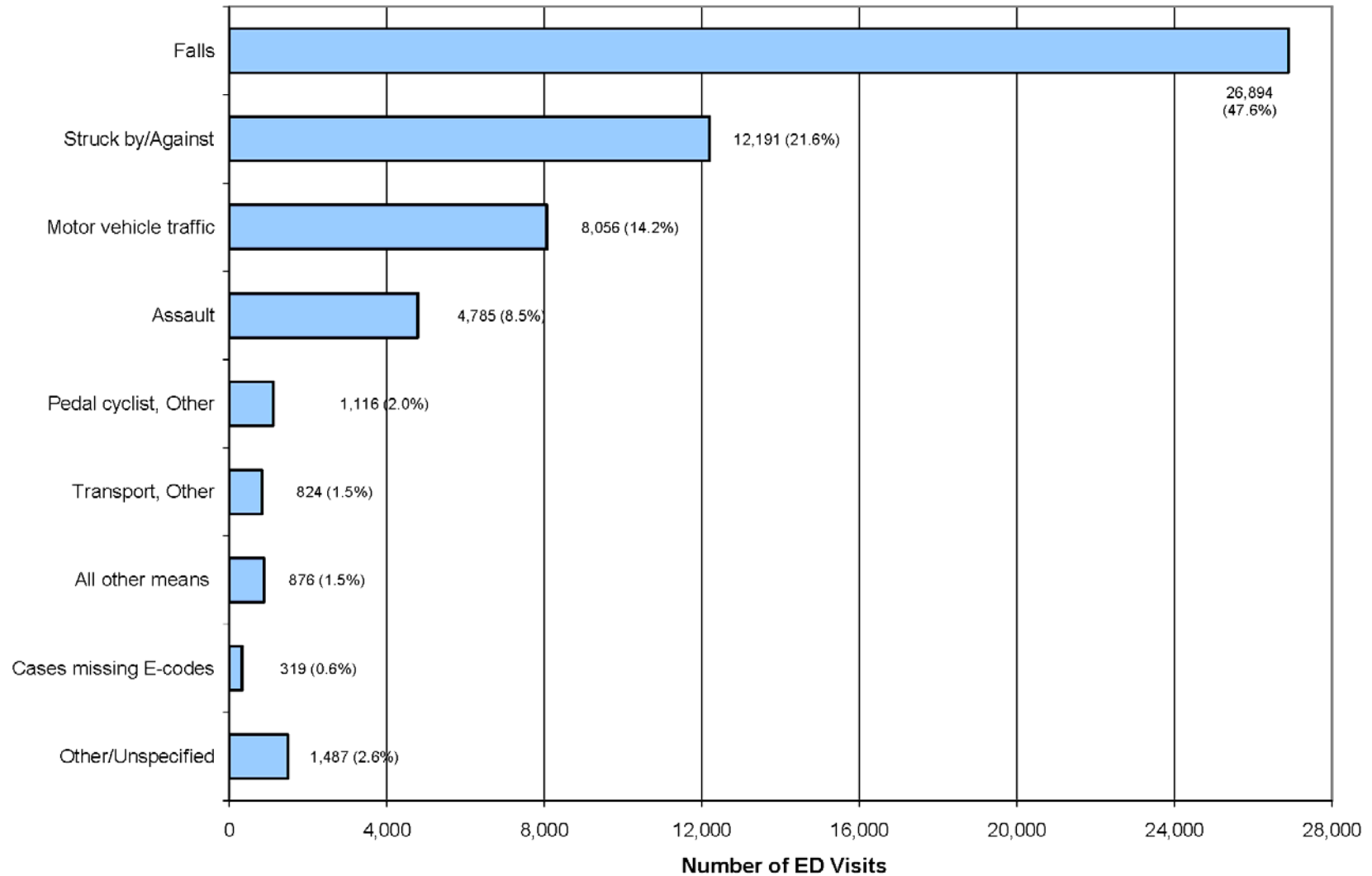
TBI Hospitalization Rates by Age & Sex
Connecticut Residents, 2005 - 2007



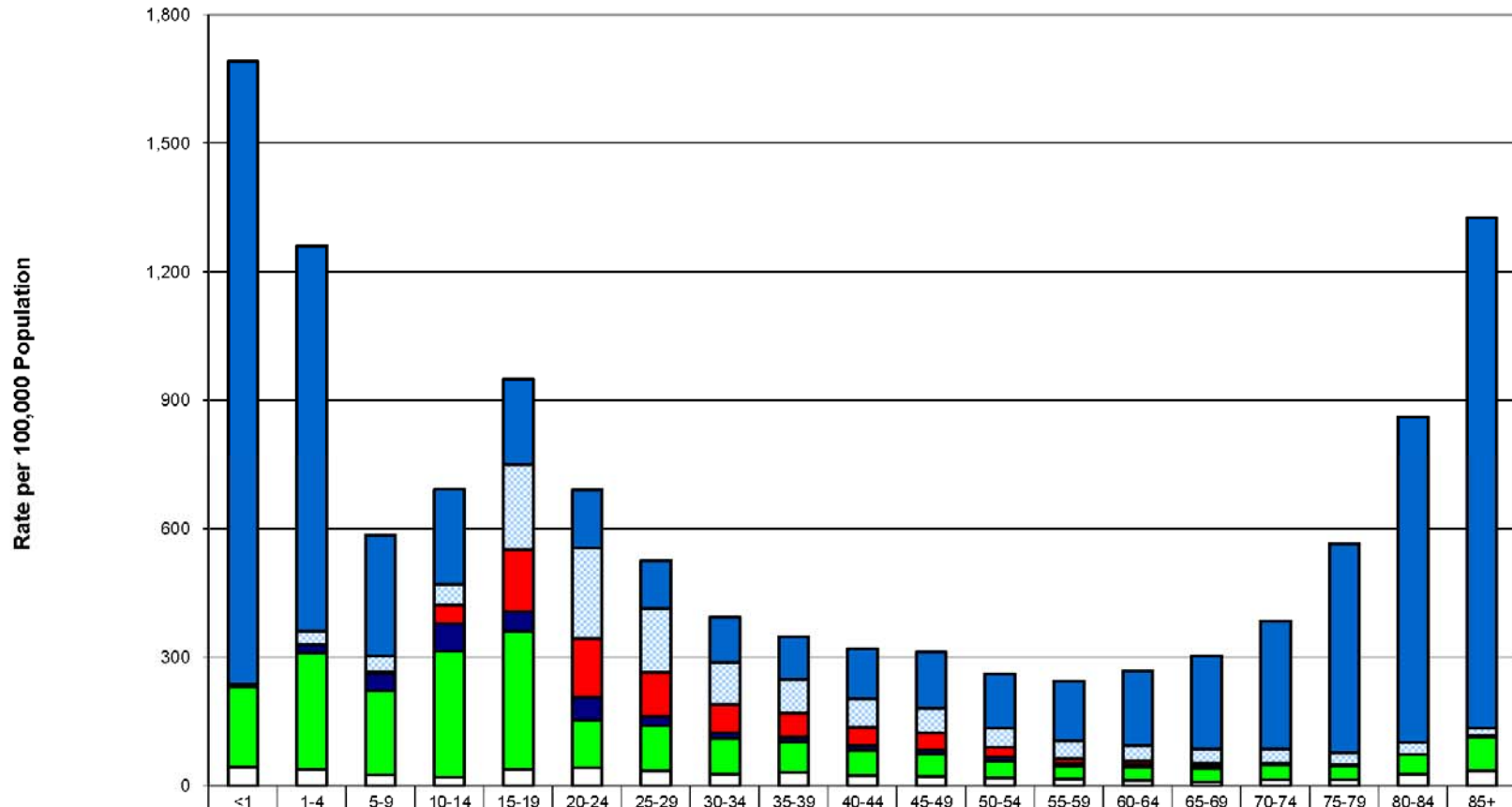
Age-Adjusted TBI Hospitalization Rates by Sex, Race/Ethnicity & County of Residence Connecticut Residents, 2005 - 2007

TBI ED Visit Rates by Mechanism & Age Connecticut Residents, 2005 - 2007

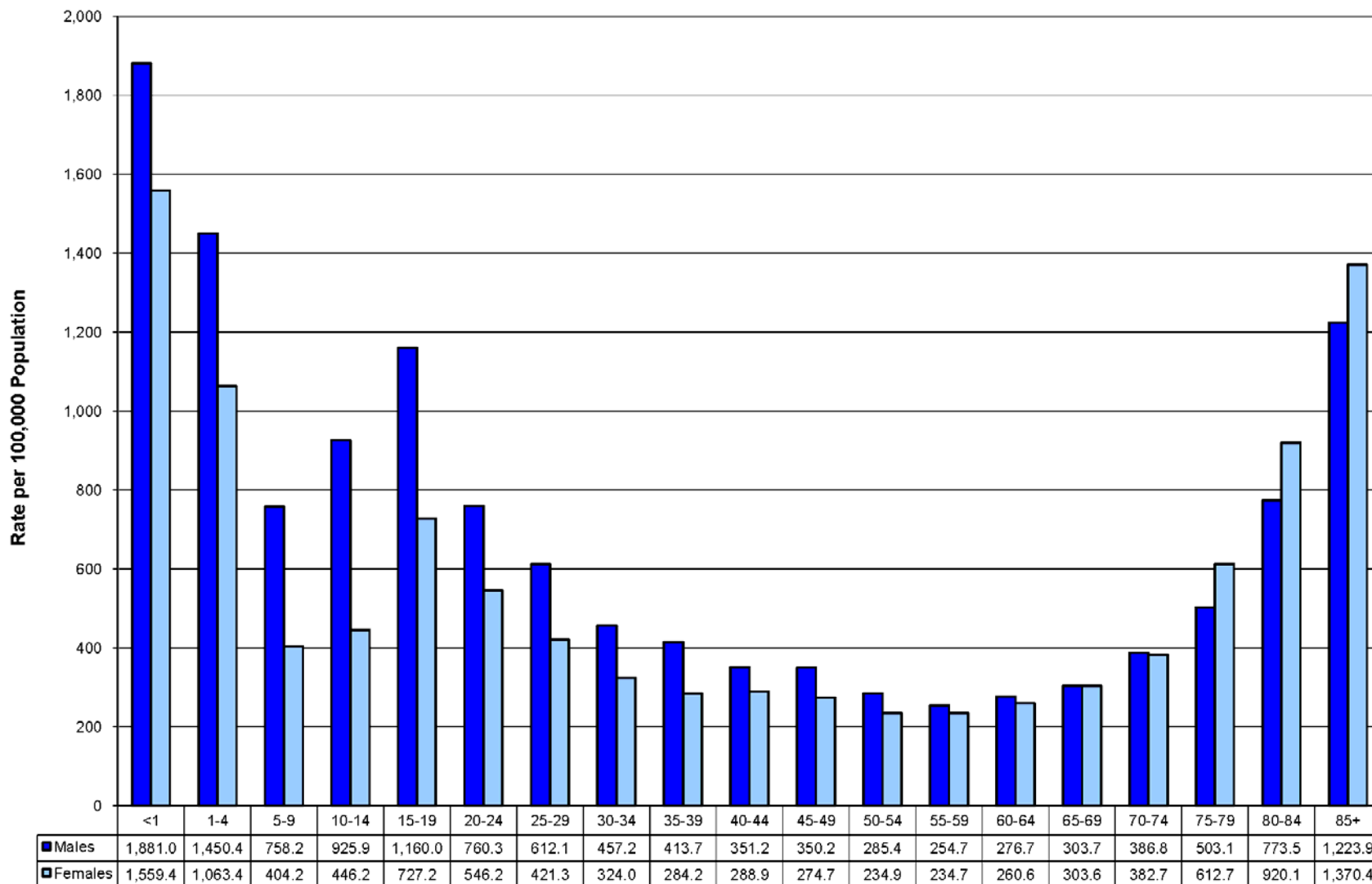
