"AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE CONNECTICUT HEALTHCARE PARTNERSHIP."

1 Strike subsection (d) of section 4 in its entirety and insert the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(d) Nothing in sections 1 to 14, inclusive, of this act shall diminish
4 any right to retiree health insurance pursuant to a collective bargaining
5 agreement or any other provision of the general statutes."

6 Strike section 11 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu
7 thereof:

8 "Sec. 11. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Office of Health
9 Reform and Innovation established under subsection (b) of section 13

10 of this act shall convene a working group to develop a plan to
11 implement a state-wide multipayer data initiative to enhance the
12 state's use of health care data from multiple sources to increase
13 efficiency, enhance outcomes and improve the understanding of health
14 care expenditures in the public and private sectors. Such group shall
15 include, but not be limited to, the Secretary of the Office of Policy and
16 Management, the Comptroller, the Commissioners of Public Health
17 and Social Services, the Insurance Commissioner, representatives of
18 health insurance companies, health insurance purchasers, hospitals,
19 consumer advocates and health care providers.

20 (b) The Office of Health Reform and Innovation shall submit, in
21 accordance with section 11-4a of the general statutes, a report on such
22 plan to the joint standing committees of the General Assembly having
23 cognizance of matters relating to appropriations, insurance and public
24 health."
