"AN ACT CREATING A PROCESS FOR FAMILY CHILD CARE PROVIDERS AND PERSONAL CARE ATTENDANTS TO COLLECTIVELY BARGAIN WITH THE STATE."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2012*) The sum of thirteen million dollars
4 is appropriated to the Department of Social Services, from the General
5 Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, to increase (1) the
6 subsidy for family child care providers providing child care services
7 under the child care subsidy program established pursuant to section
8 17b-749 of the general statutes (A) in a family day care home, as
9 defined in section 19a-77 of the general statutes; or (B) in a home not
10 requiring a license pursuant to subdivision (4) of subsection (b) of
11 section 19a-77 of the general statutes, and (2) the benefit for consumers
12 receiving services from a personal care attendant under a state-funded
13 program, including, but not limited to, (A) the program for individuals
14 with acquired brain injuries, established pursuant to section 17b-260a

15 of the general statutes, (B) the personal care assistance program,
16 established pursuant to section 17b-605a of the general statutes, (C) the
17 Connecticut home care program for the elderly, established pursuant
18 to section 17b-342 of the general statutes, (D) the pilot program to
19 provide home care services to disabled persons, established pursuant
20 to section 17b-617 of the general statutes, (E) the individual and family
21 support waiver program administered by the Department of
22 Developmental Services, (F) the comprehensive waiver program
23 administered by the Department of Developmental Services, or (G) any
24 state-funded program that provides services from a personal care
25 attendant.

26 Sec. 2. (*Effective July 1, 2012*) The sum of two million dollars is
27 appropriated to the Department of Social Services, from the General
28 Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, to establish training
29 programs for (1) family child care providers providing child care
30 services under the child care subsidy program established pursuant to
31 section 17b-749 of the general statutes (A) in a family day care home,
32 as defined in section 19a-77 of the general statutes, or (B) in a home not
33 requiring a license pursuant to subdivision (4) of subsection (b) of
34 section 19a-77 of the general statutes, and (2) personal care attendants
35 providing services under a state-funded program, including, but not
36 limited to, (A) the program for individuals with acquired brain
37 injuries, established pursuant to section 17b-260a of the general
38 statutes, (B) the personal care assistance program, established pursuant
39 to section 17b-605a of the general statutes, (C) the Connecticut home
40 care program for the elderly, established pursuant to section 17b-342 of
41 the general statutes, (D) the pilot program to provide home care
42 services to disabled persons, established pursuant to section 17b-617 of
43 the general statutes, (E) the individual and family support waiver
44 program administered by the Department of Developmental Services,
45 (F) the comprehensive waiver program administered by the
46 Department of Developmental Services, or (G) any state-funded
47 program that provides services from a personal care attendant."
