- 1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
 - 2 internal references accordingly:
 - 3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (i) of section 10-221a of the general statutes is

4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*
5 *1, 2013*):

6 (i) (1) A local or regional board of education may award a diploma
7 to a veteran, as defined in section 27-103, of World War II or the
8 Korean hostilities, as described in section 51-49h, who [left] withdrew
9 from high school prior to graduation in order to serve in the armed
10 forces of the United States and did not receive a diploma as a
11 consequence of such service.

12 (2) A local or regional board of education may award a diploma to
13 any person who (A) withdrew from high school prior to graduation to
14 work in a job that assisted the war effort during World War II,
15 December 7, 1941, to December 31, 1946, inclusive, (B) did not receive a
16 diploma as a consequence of such work, and (C) has been a resident of
17 the state for at least fifty consecutive years."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
