House Bill No. 7044

House of Representatives, May 7, 2015

The Committee on Appropriations reported through REP. WALKER of the 93rd Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES FOR PROGRAMS AND SERVICES RELATED TO HIGHER EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2015*) Not later than January 1, 2016, the
2 Board of Regents for Higher Education, the Office of Financial and
3 Academic Affairs for Higher Education and the Board of Trustees for
4 The University of Connecticut shall each submit a report, in
5 accordance with section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint
6 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
7 matters relating to appropriations and the budgets of state agencies.
8 Said board of regents, said office and said board of trustees shall
9 include in the report (1) an assessment of the effectiveness and benefits
10 of the programs and services it administers or provides, and (2) an
11 assignment of priority for the continued funding of such programs and
12 services. In addition, said board of regents and said office shall include
13 in the report an assessment of the effectiveness and benefits of any
14 programs and services administered or provided by a constituent unit

15 of the state system of higher education for which said board or said
16 office has oversight.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
