AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF ELECTRONIC AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE CARDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allow motorists who
- 2 receive proof of insurance electronically from their insurer to use such
- 3 electronic proof of insurance through an application on their smart
- 4 phone or other device for the purposes of motor vehicle traffic stops
- 5 and registering the motor vehicle with the Department of Motor
- 6 Vehicles.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow the use of electronic insurance cards for the purposes of motor vehicle traffic stops and automobile registration.
