AN ACT REQUIRING THE FURNISHING OF BOATING SAFETY INFORMATION TO PERSONS PURCHASING OR RENTING A WATERCRAFT THAT DOES NOT REQUIRE A BOATING SAFETY COURSE PRIOR TO OPERATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of
- 2 Energy and Environmental Protection to provide boating safety
- 3 information to any person who purchases or rents a watercraft that
- 4 does not otherwise require a boating safety course prior to operation.

Statement of Purpose:

To promote boating safety in the state on both public and private waterways.
