**AN ACT REFORMING MOTOR VEHICLE PROPERTY TAXES AND  
FUNDING THE REBUILDING OF OUR TRANSPORTATION  
INFRASTRUCTURE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to end a municipality's ability
- 2 to levy personal property tax on motor vehicles and to implement a
- 3 state-wide property tax on motor vehicles based on assessed value and
- 4 at a rate equal to a state-wide mill rate of twenty-five mills, and to
- 5 further provide that one hundred per cent of the revenue derived from
- 6 such tax be directed to the Special Transportation Fund to be used
- 7 exclusively to pay for transportation infrastructure.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To reform the property tax on motor vehicles and to fund the rebuilding of our transportation infrastructure.
