AN ACT CONCERNING LOTTERY WINNERS WHO ARE TAX DELINQUENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 226 of the general statutes be amended to require that,
- 2 when any person redeems a winning lottery ticket worth ten thousand
- 3 dollars or more, the Connecticut Lottery Corporation shall (1) check
- 4 the name and other identifying information of such person against a
- 5 state tax delinquency database, and (2) if such person is included on
- 6 the list of tax obligors, withhold from the lottery winnings payable to
- 7 such person the amount of such tax obligation.

Statement of Purpose:

To require individuals who have delinquent state tax obligations to pay any taxes owed to the state before receiving lottery winnings.
