AN ACT APPROPRIATING STATE FUNDS TO THE TOWN OF REDDING FOR A LICENSED CLINICAL SOCIAL WORKER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That (1) the sum of forty-five thousand dollars be appropriated to
- 2 the town of Redding, from the General Fund, for each of the fiscal
- 3 years ending June 30, 2016, and June 30, 2017, for the purpose of
- 4 employing a licensed clinical social worker to provide outreach to
- 5 residents on mental health issues for a period of two years, and (2) at
- 6 the conclusion of the two-year period, the town of Redding report to
- 7 the public health and human services committees concerning the
- 8 outcomes of the outreach provided by the licensed clinical social
- 9 worker.

Statement of Purpose:

To identify and serve at-risk individuals through public outreach and coordination with community agencies.
