AN ACT CONCERNING THE FIREARM PERMIT APPEALS PROCESS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (c) of section 29-32b of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to require the Board of Firearms Permit Examiners to hear an
- 3 appeal regarding the failure, refusal, revocation or limitation of a
- 4 firearm permit or certificate within one hundred twenty days after
- 5 receipt of the appeal, and subsection (d) of section 29-32b of the
- 6 general statutes be amended to require said board to hold hearings at
- 7 least once a month.

Statement of Purpose:

To limit the time frame during which firearm permit appeals must be heard by the Board of Firearms Permit Examiners.
