***AN ACT PERMITTING REFERENCES TO CANDIDATES WHO ARE
NOT OPPONENTS IN CAMPAIGN COMMUNICATIONS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 That chapters 155 and 157 of the general statutes be amended to
2 permit a candidate who is participating in the Citizens' Election
3 Program to refer to another candidate who is not the opponent of such
4 participating candidate in political communications on behalf of the
5 participating candidate, provided (1) the reference to the other
6 candidate is made for the sole purpose of promoting the success of the
7 candidate making such communication, and (2) there is no consent,
8 coordination or consultation between the candidate making such
9 communication and the opponent of the candidate being referred to in
10 such communication.

Statement of Purpose:

To permit a candidate who is participating in the Citizens' Election Program to reference candidates who are not the opponent of such candidate in campaign communications.
