***RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE
CONSTITUTION CONCERNING THE TERMS OF OFFICE OF
MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.***

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That section 10 of article third of the Constitution of the state be
- 2 amended to prohibit any senator or representative from serving more
- 3 than two consecutive terms in such office and that sections 8 and 10 of
- 4 article third of the Constitution of the state be amended to increase the
- 5 term of office for state representatives and state senators from two
- 6 years to four years.

Statement of Purpose:

To create term limits for members of the General Assembly and to increase the term of office for such members from two to four years.
