**AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SENIOR CITIZEN VOLUNTEER SERVICE
PROPERTY TAX CREDIT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 203 of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 municipalities to provide a property tax credit to senior citizens who
- 3 volunteer in the municipality in which they reside. Such credit shall be
- 4 awarded on a sliding scale based on the number of hours volunteered,
- 5 provided no such credit shall exceed two thousand dollars.

Statement of Purpose:

To incentivize senior citizens to volunteer in their community by providing property tax relief.
