***AN ACT REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION TO STUDY THE EXPANSION OF WASTEWATER DISPOSAL SYSTEMS IN EASTERN CONNECTICUT.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Energy and  
2 Environmental Protection shall conduct a study on the need for  
3 expansion of wastewater disposal facilities and systems in eastern  
4 Connecticut. Such study shall include, but need not be limited to, the  
5 development of a master plan to identify and prioritize areas in eastern  
6 Connecticut that are in urgent need of such expansion and  
7 recommendations on ways in which such expansion can be achieved  
8 while easing the fiscal burden of such facilities on local municipalities  
9 in eastern Connecticut. Not later than February 1, 2016, the  
10 commissioner shall submit a report, in accordance with section 11-4a  
11 of the general statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General  
12 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the environment.  
13 Such report shall include, but not be limited to, any requisite  
14 legislation to facilitate the implementation of the recommendations  
15 developed pursuant to such study.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
