**AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING FOR CERTAIN AFTER-SCHOOL
AND SUMMER PROGRAMS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the sum of five million dollars be appropriated to the
- 2 Department of Education, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year
- 3 ending June 30, 2016, for the purpose of expanding after-school and
- 4 summer programs offered at schools by school staff or outside
- 5 providers and that include project-based learning and activities that
- 6 align with school curriculum and increase health, learning and school
- 7 connectedness.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding for certain after-school and summer programs that provide enrichment to students.
