AN ACT ALLOWING BROWNFIELD REMEDIATION FUNDS TO BE USED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SHORELINE PROTECTION MEASURES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 32-763 and 32-765 of the general statutes be amended
- 2 to allow brownfield remediation and development grants and loans to
- 3 be used for the construction of bulkheads and shoreline protection
- 4 measures for waterfront properties.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow brownfield remediation and development funds to be used for shoreline protection measures in order to keep capped contaminated soil from migrating into adjacent bodies of water.
