**AN ACT CONCERNING THE COASTAL JURISDICTION LINE FOR  
TIDAL, COASTAL OR NAVIGABLE WATERS OF THE STATE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (d) of section 22a-359 of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to include pipes, culverts and man-made structures for
- 3 marking the coastal jurisdiction line for the tidal, coastal or navigable
- 4 waters of the state.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To allow certain man-made structures and objects to be used to mark the coastal jurisdiction for tidal, coastal and navigable waters of the state.
