**AN ACT CONCERNING SOLE PROPRIETORS AND WORKERS'  
COMPENSATION INSURANCE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to eliminate the requirement
- 2 that an individual employed as a subcontractor who is a sole
- 3 proprietor and employs no employees maintain a workers'
- 4 compensation insurance policy, provided such sole proprietor sign a
- 5 waiver releasing the state and the general contractor for which such
- 6 sole proprietor provides services from any liability for any injury
- 7 sustained in the course of employment.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To waive the requirement that certain subcontractors maintain a worker's compensation insurance policy provided they sign a waiver releasing the state and general contractors of liability.
