**AN ACT REDUCING THE SPEED LIMIT IN TRAFFIC INCIDENT
MANAGEMENT ZONES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 14-212a of the general statutes be amended to authorize
- 2 the Commissioner of Transportation, Commissioner of Emergency
- 3 Services and Public Protection or local traffic authority to reduce the
- 4 speed limit in a traffic incident management zone to fifteen miles per
- 5 hour.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect emergency response personnel at the scene of an emergency from oncoming traffic by authorizing the reduction of the speed limit to fifteen miles per hour.
