***AN ACT CONCERNING A TWO-GENERATIONAL SCHOOL
READINESS AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT PLAN.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to create a state-wide plan to
- 2 facilitate the educational and economic success of low-income
- 3 households by viewing such households as two-generational units
- 4 comprised of individuals requiring educational services and those
- 5 requiring career readiness services. The plan shall include: (1)
- 6 Strategies to help such households access early learning programs,
- 7 adult education, job training and other related support services; (2)
- 8 methods to streamline the provision of services through the colocation
- 9 of child and adult service providers; (3) strategies to coordinate and
- 10 utilize both public and private entities and organizations that offer
- 11 services within low-income communities; (4) modalities enabling
- 12 partnerships with both state and national philanthropic bodies to
- 13 enable state-wide replication and implementation of the plan; and (5)
- 14 creation of an interagency work group to oversee the implementation

15 of the plan and the provision of its services within the targeted
16 communities.

Statement of Purpose:

To implement a two-generational school readiness and workforce development plan.
