**RESOLUTION AMENDING THE STATE CONSTITUTION TO REQUIRE
A TWO-THIRDS VOTE TO ENACT NEW MUNICIPAL MANDATES.**

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That article third of the Constitution of the state be amended to
- 2 require the approval by a vote of at least two-thirds of the members of
- 3 each house of the General Assembly for the enactment of any bill
- 4 constituting a new mandate to local governments.

Statement of Purpose:

To require a two-thirds vote of the General Assembly before a new municipal mandate can be enacted.
