Title: AN ACT CONCERNING DEMOLITION LICENSURE AND DEMOLITION PERMITS.

Statement of Purpose: To (1) exempt from registration for a demolition permit a person engaged in the disassembly of nonstructural building materials for the purpose of reusing and recycling the building materials, and (2) require an applicant for a demolition permit to furnish a written declaration that the town or city and its agents shall be saved harmless from any claim arising out of negligence of the applicant or the applicant's agents or employees during the demolition.
