**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING ALLOWABLE COSTS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF CERTAIN OVERSIZED WATER MAINS.

**Statement of Purpose:** To allow a municipality that installs a larger than necessary water main for the provision of water to a contaminated drinking water area and for requisite firefighting flow needs to be eligible to receive a grant from the state for the costs associated with such water main and, for purposes of diversion exemptions, to provide a larger area in which a backup well can be located where the primary well is out of service.
