Title: AN ACT CONCERNING SUPPLEMENTAL FIRST RESPONDERS.

Statement of Purpose: To (1) permit any emergency medical services provider to apply to the Commissioner of Public Health for a supplemental first responder license, and (2) require that the local emergency medical services plan include a description of the coordination and cooperation between the primary service area responder and an emergency medical services provider with a supplemental first responder license.
