OFA Fiscal Note

Reduces Cost In Bill

The amendment exempts seasonal workers from the minimum wage increases established in the underlying bill. This results in a potential savings to the state and municipalities to the extent seasonal employees earn minimum wage and work not more than 120 calendar days in any calendar year.
