AN ACT INCREASING THE FINE FOR OPERATING AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE AT AN UNREASONABLE RATE OF SPEED OR IN A NEGLIGENT MANNER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 To amend section 14-386a of the general statutes to increase the fine
- 2 for operating an all-terrain vehicle at an unreasonable or imprudent rate
- 3 of speed for existing conditions or in a negligent manner so as to
- 4 endanger any person or property from two hundred fifty dollars to one
- 5 thousand dollars.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the fine for operating an all-terrain vehicle at an unreasonable rate of speed or in a negligent manner.
