Re: Support for  
**Afterschool Grant Funding**  
*February 12, 2020*

Senator Osten, Representative Walker, and the Appropriations Committee:

My name is Sharon Tripp and I am the Executive Director of Organized Parents Make A Difference, Inc. We are a non-profit agency that offers before and after school academic enrichment programs in the Hartford Public Schools serving approximately 400 students each school day as early as 7:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. To keep cost affordable, the State Afterschool Grant funding is essential.

Our agency serves low income working parents. The bottom line is that if these parents don't have access to quality affordable before and after school programs then they can't work, or, worst their children are left home unsupervised. We all know what damage can occur when hundreds of children are left alone. For a family consisting of a single parent and a child our before and after-school program cost is \$2,000 each year to provide academic and social enrichment for the child. If the parent has no before or after-school program support and must leave their job, the cost to the state would be upwards of \$50,000 according to the CT Department of Social Services guidelines. So, your choice is a mere \$2,000 price tag, or a \$50,000 price tag per child.

I ask that you fully fund the state-wide after school grant so that OPMAD and many other agencies can continue to offer families the academic and social support their children need to succeed, and so that parents can continue to work and will not need State assistance. The loss of this funding would be a high price for the State to pay, but it would be an even higher price for families.
