S.B. No. 250 (RAISED) GENERAL LAW. 'AN ACT CONCERNING FLAT GLASS OCCUPATIONAL LICENSING', to require the Commissioner of Consumer Protection to amend existing regulations regarding flat glass occupational licensing.

REF. GENERAL LAW

S.B. No. 251 (RAISED) GENERAL LAW. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE AVAILABILITY OF GENERIC PHARMACEUTICALS', to preserve consumer access to affordable generic drugs.

REF. GENERAL LAW

S.B. No. 252 (RAISED) GENERAL LAW. 'AN ACT CONCERNING NUISANCE CALLS', to require telemarketers to inform consumers they may request their telephone numbers to be placed on the do not call list.

REF. GENERAL LAW

S.B. No. 253 (RAISED) GENERAL LAW. 'AN ACT CONCERNING FAIR REIMBURSEMENT TO RETAIL DEALERS OF POWER EQUIPMENT', to ensure fair reimbursement to retail dealers of power equipment regarding certain warranty claims.

REF. GENERAL LAW

S.B. No. 254 (RAISED) GENERAL LAW. 'AN ACT CONCERNING CERTAIN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE SYSTEMS', to allow certain alcoholic liquor permittees to use self-pour automated systems.

REF. GENERAL LAW

S.B. No. 255 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING INVESTMENT OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL FUNDS', to allow for the investment of funds held in certain trusts established by municipalities, or in which municipalities may participate, to be invested in trust funds administered, held or invested by the Treasurer.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

S.B. No. 256 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT INCREASING THE PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR FARM BUILDINGS', to increase from one hundred thousand dollars to one hundred fifty thousand dollars the municipal property tax exemption for buildings used (1) actually and exclusively in farming, or (2) to provide housing for seasonal employees of a farmer.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

S.B. No. 257 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING COMMUNITY INVESTMENT BOARDS AND NEIGHBORHOOD ASSISTANCE', to (1) require certain municipalities to establish community investment boards to identify priorities for the use of municipal revenue sharing grants and select grants for payment in lieu of taxes, (2) require the Office of Policy and Management to accept proposals for solutions to problems specific to urban areas and establish pilot programs to implement such proposals, and (3) establish a task force to study issues concerning nonprofit providers.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

S.B. No. 258 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING CERTIFICATES OF APPROVAL FOR THE LOCATION OF MOTOR VEHICLE DEALERSHIPS AND REPAIR SHOPS', to specify that applicants for licenses for dealing in or repairing motor vehicles in towns or cities having zoning commissions, combined planning and zoning commissions and boards of appeals shall obtain certificates of approval of location from the town or city's zoning commission rather than its board of appeals.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

S.B. No. 259 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING NOTICE OF TAX DELINQUENCY', to (1) recognize, in certain situations, that other individuals perform tax collection duties, (2) specify that certain actions shall serve as constructive notice to certain individuals for purposes of tax delinquency sales of real property, and (3) revise a certain provision to account for instances in which the redemption by a delinquent taxpayer of the real property at issue occurs prior to the delinquency sale of such property.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

S.B. No. 260 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT EXTENDING THE MUNICIPAL REVALUATION DEADLINE FOR THE TOWN OF HAMDEN BY ONE YEAR', to extend the municipal revaluation deadline for the town of Hamden by one year.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

S.B. No. 261 (RAISED) PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY. 'AN ACT DESIGNATING SPECIAL POLICE OFFICERS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE SERVICES AS PEACE OFFICERS', to redefine "peace officer" to include a special police officer in the Department of Revenue Services and to make conforming changes.

REF. PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY

S.B. No. 262 (RAISED) PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY. 'AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF THE USE OF COMBUSTIBLE GAS DETECTORS', to study whether to require the use of combustible gas detectors in new construction with natural gas connections.

REF. PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY

S.B. No. 263 (RAISED) PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY. 'AN ACT ALLOWING AN EMERGENCY CONTACT ACCESS TO A DWELLING UNIT WITHOUT THE TENANT'S CONSENT UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES', to allow a person designated as an emergency contact of a tenant of a dwelling unit to access the unit under certain circumstances.

REF. PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY

S.B. No. 264 (RAISED) PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING MOTOR VEHICLE INSPECTORS AND BUILDING SECURITY', to allow the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles to nominate, and the Commissioner of Emergency Services and Public Protection to appoint, motor vehicle inspectors to serve as special police officers at Department of Motor Vehicles' buildings and on department lands.

REF. PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY

S.B. No. 265 (RAISED) PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING REIMBURSEMENT OF FIREFIGHTER TRAINING COSTS', to require a fire department to be reimbursed for a portion of the costs of the entry-level training of a firefighter who is subsequently hired by another department within two years of the completion of the firefighter's entry-level training.

REF. PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY

S.B. No. 266 (RAISED) PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING BODY ARMOR FOR FIREFIGHTERS AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PERSONNEL', to (1) allow firefighters, fire departments, emergency services personnel and emergency medical service organizations to purchase or receive body armor without meeting the transferor of such body armor in person, and (2) require fire departments and emergency medical service organizations to equip their vehicles with body armor.

REF. PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY

S.B. No. 267 (RAISED) PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY. 'AN ACT ESTABLISHING A DEPARTMENT OF CIVILIAN JUSTICE', to establish a Department of Civilian Justice to receive and investigate complaints from a police officer alleging misconduct by another police officer in the performance of the officer's duties.

REF. PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY

S.B. No. 268 (RAISED) PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING INTEREST ON LOTTERY SALES AGENT DELINQUENCY ASSESSMENTS', to (1) specify that simple interest is charged on delinquency assessments of lottery sales agents, and (2) allow an agent whose delinquency assessment remains due and was subject to compounding interest to request a hardship waiver from the Commissioner of Consumer Protection to recalculate the interest owed.

REF. PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY

S.B. No. 269 (RAISED) PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING CERTIFICATION OF INDEPENDENT INSPECTORS AND INSPECTION FIRMS TO PERFORM ELEVATOR, ESCALATOR AND STATE BUILDING CODE INSPECTIONS', to establish a program to certify independent inspectors and inspection firms to perform State Building Code and elevator and escalator inspections.

REF. PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY

S.B. No. 270 (RAISED) PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY. 'AN ACT REQUIRING POLICE OFFICERS AND VEHICLES WITH BLUE LIGHTS TO BE STATIONED IN CERTAIN HIGHWAY WORK ZONES', to require the Department of Transportation to ensure that a state or local public safety officer and a vehicle displaying blue lights are stationed within certain highway work zones.

REF. PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY

S.B. No. 271 (RAISED) TRANSPORTATION. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE FISCAL ACCOUNTABILITY AND SUSTAINABLE TRANSPORTATION REFORM PLAN', to (1) establish a Transportation Strategy and Advisory Board, and a Connecticut and New York Railroad Strategy Board; (2) require the Commissioner of Transportation to provide certain information to the Transportation Strategy and Advisory Board and the Connecticut and New York Railroad Strategy Board; (3) limit the aggregate maximum amount of TIFIA and RRIF loan agreements the state can enter into for the period commencing on July 1, 2022, and ending on December 31, 2030; (4) transfer the sum of one billion five hundred million dollars from the Budget Reserve Fund to the State Employees Retirement Fund for the purpose of paying unfunded past service liability; and (5) require the Auditors of Public Accounts to conduct certain audits of the Department of Transportation.

REF. TRANSPORTATION

S.B. No. 272 (RAISED) HUMAN SERVICES. 'AN ACT ADDING ACUPUNCTURISTS AND CHIROPRACTORS TO THE LIST OF PERMISSIBLE REIMBURSABLE MEDICAID SERVICES', to provide Medicaid reimbursement for chiropractors and acupuncturists.

REF. HUMAN SERVICES

S.B. No. 273 (RAISED) HUMAN SERVICES. 'AN ACT CREATING A TASK FORCE TO CONSIDER DUAL DELIVERY OF STATE-ADMINISTERED HUMAN SERVICES BY COMMUNITY NONPROFIT AGENCIES', to explore more efficient and effective delivery of state-administered human services via provision of more services by community nonprofit agencies.

REF. HUMAN SERVICES

S.B. No. 274 (RAISED) HUMAN SERVICES. 'AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING FOR PLANNED PARENTHOOD AND OTHER FAMILY PLANNING CLINICS', to offset the loss of federal funds for family planning clinics.

REF. HUMAN SERVICES

S.B. No. 275 (RAISED) HUMAN SERVICES. 'AN ACT REQUIRING FAMILY NOTIFICATIONS IN STATE ESTATE RECOVERIES', to require the state to make efforts to notify immediate family members before taking over the administration of a decedent's estate for payment of state assistance or care provided to the decedent.

REF. HUMAN SERVICES

S.B. No. 276 (RAISED) HUMAN SERVICES. 'AN ACT REQUIRING DRIVERS OF PARATRANSIT VEHICLES TO REPORT SUSPECTED ABUSE, NEGLIGENCE OR EXPLOITATION OF ELDERLY PERSONS', to make drivers of paratransit vehicles mandated reporters of suspected abuse, neglect, exploitation or abandonment of elderly persons.
