The Committee on Planning and Development reported through SEN. CASSANO of the 4th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING THE BOLTON LAKES REGIONAL WATER POLLUTION CONTROL AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) As used in this section, "Bolton
2 Lakes Regional Water Pollution Control Authority" means the regional
3 water pollution control authority established on April 23, 2003,
4 pursuant to the provisions of sections 22a-500 to 22a-519, inclusive, of
5 the general statutes, by adoption of concurrent ordinances of the
6 legislative bodies of the towns of Bolton and Vernon and "board of
7 directors" means the board of directors of such authority appointed in
8 accordance with the provisions of such concurrent ordinances.

9 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (c) of section 22a-
10 500 of the general statutes, subdivision (14) of subsection (a) of section
11 22a-501 of the general statutes or subsection (b) of section 22a-517 of the
12 general statutes, any regulation adopted by the Commissioner of
13 Energy and Environmental Protection pursuant to subsection (l) of
14 section 22a-424 of the general statutes, any ordinance adopted by the

15 towns of Bolton, Vernon, Manchester or Coventry, including any
16 amendment to such ordinance, and any agreement entered into
17 pursuant to any such provision, the board of directors of the Bolton
18 Lakes Regional Water Pollution Control Authority may authorize the
19 expansion of such authority's wastewater system into the town of
20 Coventry and may take any action such board deems necessary to
21 implement such expansion.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Explanation

The bill allows the Bolton Lakes Regional Water Pollution Control Authority to authorize an expansion of their wastewater system into the town of Coventry while exempting the process from certain local and state and laws and regulations.

Any impact to the Bolton Lakes Water Pollution Control Authority and the Town of Coventry will depend on the terms of the agreement facilitated by the bill.
