Explanation

The bill allows for the establishment of a special taxing district in West Haven. There is a minimal, one-time cost to the City of West Haven associated with holding any public meetings or referenda, and with publishing associated public notices necessary to establish the district.

The bill allows the district to issue revenue bonds to support its duties. This has no impact to the city or the state, as the language specifies that such revenue bonds are not the responsibility of the City of West Haven or the State of Connecticut.

Depending on the extent of services provided by the district, there could be a savings to West Haven as the costs of providing public services shifts from the City to the District.

House "A" allows the City of West Haven to enter into agreements with the special taxing district established by the underlying bill. Any

impact to the City would depend on the provisions of any such agreement.

Senate "A" makes procedural changes regarding the issuance of bonds by the special taxing district. This has no fiscal impact.

The Out Years

The annualized ongoing fiscal impact identified above would continue into the future subject to revenue or cost-sharing agreements made between the special taxing district and the City of West Haven.
