

Dear Committee Members:

I am writing to indicate my support for proposed legislation **HB 6325** in the fight against voter fraud.

I am completely opposed to the idea of early voting. I support one single DESIGNATED Election Day with absolutely NO early voting. I support legislating a requirement for **VOTER ID**, limiting voting to a **single Election Day** using **paper** ballots and offering **verified** absentee ballots to American citizens who simply are not able for whatever reason (military, disabled, away for legitimate reasons) to vote on Election Day.

I completely oppose sending unrequested mail-in ballots. Anyone can lay their hands on these and mark them as desired as has been demonstrated in past elections nationwide.
