

Removing barriers to voting absentee would allow more people to vote in the manner most convenient for them. No excuse absentee voting would increase accessibility for minority voters, voters with disabilities, those in rural communities, and more.. A no-excuse absentee voting system is likely to reduce both polling site lines and the administrative burden on election officials, thereby decreasing the total cost of administering elections. Likewise, increase access to early voting will increase turnout among particular demographic groups, cuts wait times at the polls, and allow time for the correction of errors. The State of CT should be doing all that is necessary to make voting easier for all residents not more difficult. It's time to adopt these measures!
