

CT Government Administration and Elections Committee:

Regarding the following bills on the agenda:

H.J. No. 58:

As a resident and taxpayer in the State of CT, I am in favor of a resolution proposing a state constitutional amendment allowing no-excuse absentee voting as long as there is mandatory signature verification. The importance of verification cannot be underestimated. It is imperative that voter rolls be cleaned up to maintain voter integrity. This past national election has done nothing to bring unity to this country and a divided country will not survive. Therefore I believe that the following should be implemented:

1. Mandatory VOTER ID
2. A statewide voter registration system
3. Voter requirements for proof of citizenship
4. Maintain voter lists to find voters who are registered in other states.

H.J.No. 59:

Voting is a privilege and should be held on a single day. Make it a holiday. If a voter can't make it, then use a secure absentee ballot to vote.

S.B. No. 901 and H.B. No. 6464:
