Please do not pass the following amendments in Connecticut:

1. HJ 58 would allow universal mail-in balloting in CT. No protections like ID requirements, signature verification, etc. are in the bill.
2. HJ 59 would allow early voting, not specifying how early, and in probable violation of Congressional law and the U.S. Constitution.

It is not only a sacred right, but a privilege to vote, and those **who can come out to vote** in a safe and secure environment **should be willing to do so**. Every citizen should be required and willing to show proof of identity to ensure a true vote of the people. Mail in voting and early voting jeopardize the integrity of the entire process.
