To the GAE Committee:

I would like to express opposition to a Constitutional Amendment for No-Excuse Absentee Voting, particularly since the proposal does not specify the methods/details by which ballots would be certified or proven to be only from registered, citizen voters who are voting once per an election. In-person voting is the most cost-effective, reliable and secure method of voting. Any absentee ballots for special circumstances must be requested and not sent out unsolicited.
