I am a constituent in favor of these resolutions; they would put us in line with other states. 44 states have early voting, and 34 states have no excuse absentee voting. Due to allowing absentee voting in the 2020 election, voter turnout was 80%, with 664,000 votes cast via absentee. One of these voters was my father, who at 83 and struggling with mobility would not have voted were it not for the Absentee ballot mailed to his house. It is my belief that the Connecticut government can and should do more to ensure that every voice - my father's, mine, my classmates', my patients, and the voices of those who might vote against me - be heard.
