I am submitting written testimony on the issue addressed on H.B. 6462.

The Judicial Professional Employees Union represent over 600 peace officers.

The Police Accountability Act (P.A.A.), through Section 29 impacts peace officers by way of changes to C.G.S. 53a-22.

Many of the provisions of the Police Accountability Act are now law, one section in particular is not yet in effect. According to the current provisions of the P.A.A., the Section 29 (Use of Force) effective date is APRIL 1, 2021. H.B. 6462 proposes that the APRIL 1, 2021 date be extended until OCTOBER 1, 2022.

The operational impacts of the P.A.A. are being discovered daily and the overall concepts of the P.A.A. may still be divisive topics of public policy, myself and the peace officers I represent can agree that extending the effective date of Section 29 until OCTOBER 1, 2022 is a good first step in addressing the shortcomings of the P.A.A.
