**AN ACT PROPORTIONALLY AWARDING THE STATE'S ELECTORAL  
COLLEGE VOTES FOR PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT OF THE  
UNITED STATES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

1 That title 9 of the general statutes be amended to provide that (1) the  
2 two electors of President and Vice President of the United States  
3 corresponding to the senators in Congress to which the state is entitled  
4 shall cast their ballots for the Presidential and Vice Presidential  
5 candidates receiving the highest total of votes state-wide, and (2) each  
6 of the five such electors corresponding to the representative in Congress  
7 to which each of the state's five congressional districts is entitled shall  
8 cast such elector's respective ballot for the Presidential and Vice  
9 Presidential candidates receiving the highest total votes in the  
10 corresponding congressional district.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To more proportionally award Connecticut's Electoral College votes.
