**AN ACT CONCERNING MEDICAID REIMBURSEMENT FOR MARITAL AND FAMILY THERAPISTS PERMITTED TO PRACTICE WITHOUT LICENSES DURING A PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 17b of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Commissioner of Social Services to seek federal approval for a Medicaid
- 3 state plan amendment to provide Medicaid reimbursement, to the
- 4 extent permissible under federal law, to marital and family therapists
- 5 permitted to practice without licenses pursuant to Executive Order
- 6 Number 7V of Governor Ned Lamont.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To permit Medicaid reimbursement for services provided by marital and family therapists permitted to practice without licenses pursuant to Executive Order Number 7V of Governor Ned Lamont.
