AN ACT CONCERNING ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR RESPITE SERVICES FOR CARETAKERS OF ALZHEIMER'S PATIENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 17b-349e of the general statutes be amended to increase
- 2 the eligibility requirements for respite care services for caretakers of
- 3 Alzheimer's patients from a maximum annual income of forty-one
- 4 thousand dollars to fifty thousand dollars and a maximum amount of
- 5 liquid assets from nine thousand to twenty-seven thousand dollars.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase access to respite services for caretakers of Alzheimer's patients.
