**AN ACT CONCERNING THE DISPLAY OF THE CONSTITUTION OF
THE UNITED STATES FOR STUDENTS IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS
THROUGHOUT THE STATE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-230 of the general statutes be amended to require local
- 2 and regional boards of education to display a copy of the Constitution
- 3 of the United States in a conspicuous location, visible to all students, in
- 4 each school under the jurisdiction of such board, and that title 10 of the
- 5 general statutes be amended to provide funding to any board of
- 6 education that does not have the resources to display a copy of the
- 7 Constitution of the United States for its students.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that students are able to learn about the foundation of the rights and liberties of all citizens of the United States of America.
