AN ACT CONCERNING THE SALE AND REPAIR OF EMERGENCY APPARATUS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 246 of the general statutes be amended to (1) require any
- 2 entity engaged in the business of selling, offering for sale or repairing
- 3 new emergency apparatus to have a new car dealer's license, (2) require
- 4 any manufacturer engaged in the business of selling emergency
- 5 apparatus to have a licensed franchised dealer in the state, and (3)
- 6 permit the Department of Motor Vehicles to immediately stop the sale
- 7 or repair of emergency apparatus if an entity does not have a new car
- 8 dealer's license or if a manufacturer does not have a licensed franchised
- 9 dealer in the state.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect first responders and increase public safety by requiring entities selling and repairing emergency apparatus to be properly licensed by the Department of Motor Vehicles.
