**AN ACT CONCERNING A WAIVER OF APPLICATION FEES FOR
PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION FOR STATE
RESIDENTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10a of the general statutes be amended to require each
- 2 public institution of higher education to designate days every year on
- 3 which the application fee for an undergraduate program at such
- 4 institution shall be waived for state residents.

Statement of Purpose:

To designate days every year on which state residents may apply for
free to undergraduate programs at public institutions of higher
education in the state.
