AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROVISION OF CRITICAL SERVICES TO PERSONS SUFFERING AS A RESULT OF THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That a portion of federal dollars acquired by the state to combat the
- 2 COVID-19 pandemic be used to provide additional funding for mental
- 3 health, suicide prevention and substance use services for persons
- 4 suffering as a result of the pandemic.
