AN ACT DELAYING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PAID FAMILY AND MEDICAL LEAVE PROGRAM FOR ONE YEAR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to suspend the implementation
- 2 of Paid Family and Medical Leave Act payroll tax, retroactively from
- 3 January 1, 2021, until January 1, 2022, and delay implementation of the
- 4 benefits of Paid Family and Medical Leave Act until January 1, 2023.

Statement of Purpose:

To delay the implementation of the Paid Family and Medical Leave program for one year.
