AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF COVID-19 RELIEF FUNDS TO REPLENISH THE UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION TRUST FUND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that a certain portion
- 2 of the current or any future COVID-19 relief funds granted to the state
- 3 from the federal government be used to replenish the Unemployment
- 4 Compensation Trust Fund.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce the future tax burden on the state's businesses that are already struggling to recover from the COVID-19 pandemic.
