AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TAX-EXEMPT SCHOLARSHIP FUND TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR ALTERNATIVE COURSES OF STUDY TO LOW-INCOME AND SPECIAL EDUCATION STUDENTS DURING A DECLARED PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a scholarship fund
- 2 that allows individuals and corporations to make tax-exempt donations
- 3 for the purpose of providing scholarships to fund alternative courses of
- 4 study for low-income students and special education students during a
- 5 declared public health emergency related to a pandemic.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a tax-exempt scholarship fund to provide funding for alternative courses of study to low-income and special education students during a declared public health emergency.
