***AN ACT EXTENDING TUITION WAIVERS TO THE PARENTS OF A  
PERSON KILLED IN ACTION WHILE PERFORMING ACTIVE MILITARY  
DUTY.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 10a-77, 10a-99 and 10a-105 of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to require the Board of Regents for Higher Education and the
- 3 Board of Trustees of The University of Connecticut to waive the
- 4 payment of tuition at an institution of higher education under each
- 5 board's governance for any resident of the state whose child was killed
- 6 in action while performing active military duty with the armed forces of
- 7 the United States on or after September 11, 2001.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To provide a tuition waiver at public institutions of higher education for  
the parents of a person killed in action while performing active military  
duty with the armed forces of the United States.
