**AN ACT CONCERNING THE COLLECTION AND REPORTING OF
ADVERSE CHILDHOOD EXPERIENCES DATA.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the consistent and
- 2 comprehensive collection and reporting of data concerning adverse
- 3 childhood experiences, including those adverse childhood experiences
- 4 that occur prior to school enrollment, by the Department of Education
- 5 and other relevant local and state agencies.

Statement of Purpose:

To improve understanding of adverse childhood experiences in order to address the needs of children in the state.
